In order to be considered for membership at Wallum Lake Rod & Gun Club, you must:

1. **Complete the top section of the 13.0.1 (BCI) form, included in this packet.** Bring this form to your local or state law enforcement agency and ask them to complete and stamp the form. (Massachusetts Residents must complete a MA Resident CORI Form). Residents of states outside of RI or MA must include the appropriate State Resident BCI Form.
2. **Complete the Membership Application included in this packet and attach the completed BCI Form.**
3. **Bring your completed paperwork to the club by the 15th of the month. The Membership Committee will contact the applicant for a MANDATORY New Member Interview. Bring your dues payment with initiation fee to New Member Interview Meeting.** Applicants will be voted on by the membership at the next Membership Meeting. Membership meetings are held on the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:30 pm. Note, when the Monday meeting falls on a holiday, this meeting is held the next night at the regular time.

All new members must complete 30 volunteer work hours during the first 12 months of membership, which will be applied toward the following year's dues reduction schedule.

All members are encouraged to contribute volunteer work hours and reduce their annual dues payment.

Any work hours performed during a calendar year are applied to the following year's dues reduction.

THERE'S ALWAYS WORK TO BE DONE AT THE CLUB!!

New members will receive a letter from the New Member Correspondence Chairman every time that an event takes place at the club. This will assist the New Member in planning to join a work party for a particular event. New Members should also check the Monthly Newsletter for the schedule of events. This is also an excellent source for planning to join a work party.

Whenever a member serves time on a work party, the member should fill out a work slip and ask the Committee Chairperson to sign the work slip. The slip should then be placed in the appropriate box on sign in desk.

After it is placed in the box, a member of the Board of Trustees will sign it, and leave the yellow copy in the container on the desk.

The Membership Chairman collects the white slips once a month and monthly updates are posted on the bulletin board in the Clubhouse.

New Members are advised that they may submit one slip for work done over a few Continuous days, such as over a weekend or for a multi-day task. Round up hours to the nearest half hour.

All questions regarding dues, initiation fees, land assessment or work hours should be directed to the Membership Chairman, who is present at all monthly business meetings.
