

Skeet Range Rules

THE USE OF ALCOHOL AND OR MARIJUANA ARE NOT ALLOWED PRIOR TO SHOOTING

1. ALWAYS Practice safe firearm handling techniques.
2. ALWAYS Keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction.
3. ALWAYS Keep your finger off the trigger and outside of the trigger guard until you're ready to shoot.
4. HEARING and EYE protection must be worn when on the firing line.
5. ONLY certified personnel are authorized to open, operate, and load the target machines.
6. No magnum shot shells or shot larger than 7 1/2 No high brass or EXPRESS shells allowed.
7. Firearms may be carried between stations, but the action must remain open with no ammunition in the chamber or magazine and pointed down.
8. Load and unload only when you are on station (firing Line) and firearms must be pointed down range.
9. Do not load more than 2 rounds for doubles at one time
10. Only load 1 round at each time for station 8. One for the high house then one for the low house.
11. While an active shooter is on line 8, the other shooters are required to remain in a single line from station 4 and facing station 8.
10. Please be patient and quiet while waiting for your turn. The majority of our throwers are manually operated, and it is difficult for the operator to hear the command "pull" to release the clay.
11. Shooters may NOT shoot more than 1 round on each clay.
12. Please police your spent shells after the round is completed and properly dispose in the trash.
13. Stay safe and enjoy. Happy shooting.
