- B.O.D. meeting 10-5, 7 pm.

- We had a live meeting in Sept. under the pavilion using social distancing! Meeting highlights:
- **Due to vandalism by rifles at pit 2 on the weekend of Sept.12<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup>, by decree of pistol pits chairman, all long guns are now prohibited at ALL pistol pits as of Sept 14<sup>th</sup>. If you are caught with a long gun up there, you WILL go before the B.O.D. !! Long guns also means no Pistol Caliber Carbines! The only firearms allowed are now center fire handguns chambered in traditional handgun calibers. No .22 rim fire! The only pits open are 1,2, and 3!**
- **The above was amended by e blast 9-24. Long guns are allowed in pit 4 only, and after an orientation on long gun use by Tim Burdick or Cody Landry. Shooters must provide their own targets. The first decree was left in this newsletter to to bring attention of the serious nature of vandalism and misuse of the pistol pits. If there are any further questions, contact Tim.**

A second vote on the proposed by-law change was affirmative. One more vote at the Oct meeting is needed for staggered terms on the B.O.D. and Board of Trustees
